Exodus 1

Israel grows and is enslaved under Pharaoh's fear.

Matthew 2:1-18

Herod's fear and violence.

Wednesday, March 25th

Exodus 2

Hope rises through a preserved child and God's quiet providence.

Matthew 2:19-23

God protecting the promised Child.

Thursday, March 26th

Exodus 3

God reveals His name and calls to Moses from the fire.

John 8:48-58

Jesus reveals himself as "I Am".

Friday, March 27th

Exodus 4

God sends an unlikely deliverer with divine authority.

John 6:35-40

Jesus sent to do God's will.

Saturday, March 28th

Exodus 5:1-21

Pharaoh increases Israel's suffering and resists God's command.

Luke 19:28-48

Jesus comes to Jerusalem as king, and weeps over the city.
