14-week courses – 2 years – 36 credit hours – fully online

January – April 2023 – 6 credit hours

- [**MABT501 – Old Testament**](#) – Study God’s missional work through Abraham’s family to bring blessing to the world.
- [**MABT507 – Biblical Theology to Fuel Disciple Making**](#) – An overview of the key teachings in the Bible. From the Grand Storyline through doctrines of Scripture, God, the Fall, Israel, the Gospel, New Birth, Baptism, Saving Faith, Church, Disciple Making, Ethics, and Final Restoration.

May – August 2023 – 6 credit hours

- [**MABT503 – Jesus Christ and The Gospels**](#) – An examination of the Life of Christ based on the gospels. The geographical and cultural backgrounds of first century A.D. Palestine, as well as the travels and teachings of Christ, are brought to life.
